Re: Calumet Township Septic Tank Elimination Project

Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP) Enrollment Agreement

Dear Property Owner:

The Lake County Board of Commissioners (County) is constructing a new sanitary sewer collection system in Calumet Township. The project will provide sanitary sewer main pipe near your property. Given the close proximity of the sewer system; your property will be connected to the sewer main via a grinder pump system and/or gravity sewer lateral. The County intends to utilize American Rescue Plan Act funds to make sewer connections available, <u>free of charge</u>, for all properties. A monthly sewer bill of \$85/month would begin in approximately July 2025.

When septic systems fail, sewage is forced to the top of the ground. The result is contamination of surface water which creates a prime habitat for the breeding of mosquitos and diseases. The improvements of sanitary engineering, wastewater treatment, and sanitary sewer installation have largely eliminated the transmission of diseases through open contaminated surface water. In addition to public health and environmental benefits, economic benefits including increased property value and potential land development are direct results of having access to a public sewer system.


Attached, please find the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP) Enrollment Agreement for your review and execution. This document grants the County Right of Entry to fully complete this work. If you do not sign and execute the enclosed agreement, your parcel will not be included in the Project. Future connection to the sewer would be possible at your own expense with anticipated cost between \$20,000 and \$25,000.

NO	W, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:
1. <u>Work.</u>	
installing ar performing plans and sp existing sep	eans: Through Board's sewer main construction contractor and its subcontractors, and building sewer (also known as a sewer lateral) up to 300 feet from the sewer main and all steps required to connect Customer's structure to the Sewage Disposal System per the pecifications including sanitary sewer lateral installation; abandoning the Customer's stric tank; and, if Customer has a warranty claim as to the workmanship of the installation, work to correct the defect in workmanship as described below in Section 6.
	This agreement is intended to be for residential customers. However, small businesses may qualify or partially qualify for the program. The Board shall only be responsible for one connection per structure per land parcel.

2. Offer; Payment Terms.

- A. The Calumet STEP Connection Fee is \$2,500 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) which Customer agrees to pay in one lump sum payment on or before the due date on the confirmation that Board will send to Customer (the "Due Date"):
 - a. If Agreement is executed prior to May 15, 2024, the entire Connection Fee and cost of connection shall be waived.
- B. Customer agrees to pay the monthly sewer rate as outlined in the Lake County Sewer Rate Ordinance of \$85.00 in monthly payments beginning approximately July 2025, and more precisely within thirty (30) days of receipt of the monthly invoice.;

3. Right of Entry.

For the purposes stated herein and for no other purpose, Customer grants to Board, Board's Agents, its contractor, and its contractor's subcontractors a right of entry onto the Customer Property for the purposes of performing the Work. If Board's contractor identifies an obstruction or other structure that is or will prevent it from being able to complete the Work, then it will notify Customer, and the contractor and Customer will agree on how to remove the obstruction or other structure or a reasonable way to work around it. Board (or one of its contractors) will restore the Customer Property as close to its original condition as reasonably possible, including placing grass seed on any grassy areas impacted as part of the Work.

4. Assignment.

Customer is not allowed to assign this Agreement to any other person without the written consent of the Board. This Agreement is binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.

5. Customer Representation and Warranties.

Customer represents and warrants that he or she is, or they are, the owner(s) of the Customer Property and therefore has (or have) sole and exclusive right to grant and convey the Right of Entry described above and to provide Board, its contractor, and its contractor's subcontractors with all rights and privileges necessary to complete the Work. Only the owner(s) of the Customer Property are allowed to enter into this Agreement. Renters and others are not allowed to sign this Agreement.

6. Warranty on Workmanship.

Board warrants the workmanship of the Work for two years from the date the Work was originally performed.

7. Miscellaneous.

a. Governing Law; Litigation.

This Agreement shall be governed by and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana. Litigation associated with or arising under this Agreement is allowed to be filed only in the state courts located in Lake County, Indiana.

b. **Environmental Liability.**

Customer agrees that neither Board nor its contractor nor its contractor's subcontractors shall be liable for environmentally related claims arising from or related to conditions on the Customer Property prior to the beginning of the Work.

c. Entire Agreement; Amendments.

This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement and understanding between Customer and Board. Customer and Board agree that no other agreements or promises, verbal or written, exist between them. This Agreement may be amended only by the express, written agreement of both Customer and Board.

8. Notice.

Board will send Customer the confirmation and Due Date for the Connection Fee Payment, and the acknowledgment of receipt of that Payment, to Customer's address. Other notices given pursuant to this Agreement will be in writing and either mailed by regular or certified mail or delivered by a nationally recognized overnight courier service to the other party's address as follows:

9. Offer Only Valid Until Date Stated Below.

The connection option shall be valid only for terms stated in Section 2. The option expires at 5 p.m. on the stated term. In other words, Board will have no obligation to anyone who does not return a signed Agreement to Board before 5 p.m. on that date.
